Page 4, sections 10-11

Sec. 10. "Telemarketer" means a person who makes or causes another person to make a telemarketing call. The term includes, without limitation, a person registered with the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Business and Industry as a seller or salesman pursuant to chapter 599B of NRS. The term does not include a person who is licensed and regulated by a state agency as a requirement for engaging in a profession or occupation in this state, and when any solicited transaction cannot be concluded without a face-to-face meeting between the caller and the person who is called.

Sec. 11. "Telemarketing call" means a telephone call,
including, without limitation, a call dialed by a device for
automatic dialing or device for automatic dialing and announcing,
the primary purpose of which is to solicit a person who accepts the
call to purchase, lease, invest in or otherwise acquire goods or
services. The term does not include a telephone call made on
behalf of a charitable organization, the primary purpose of which
is to solicit a person who accepts the call to donate money, goods
or services to the charitable organization or any telephone call for
which the solicited transaction cannot be concluded without a face-toface meeting between the caller and the person who is called.
