All credits earned by a student in a course at a community college within the University and Community College System (UCCSN) must be accepted toward the work required for a baccalaureate degree at any other institution of the UCCSN.

Proponents: The bill would ensure that credits earned in courses leading to an associated of applied science degree would transfer to a university and count toward a major or minor. This would be particularly applicable to articulation with programs at Nevada State College.
