Section 3 Amendment

At page 2, line 15, change "60 days" to "90 days."

Section 4

Amendment

At page 2, line 44, change "60 days" to "90 days."

Comment

Under the bill as drafted, an employee whose license lapsed will generally have 60 days to reinstate his license or his employment will be deemed to have terminated by operation of law. Our amendment would extend this period to 90 days. A 90-day period is consistent with the existing provisions of NRS 391.313, relating to admonitions, and makes it more likely that an employee who can reinstate his license will have a fair opportunity to do so.

We have discussed the proposed amendment with the Clark County School District – on whose behalf the bill was drafted – and the District has indicated that it is agreeable to the 90-day period.
