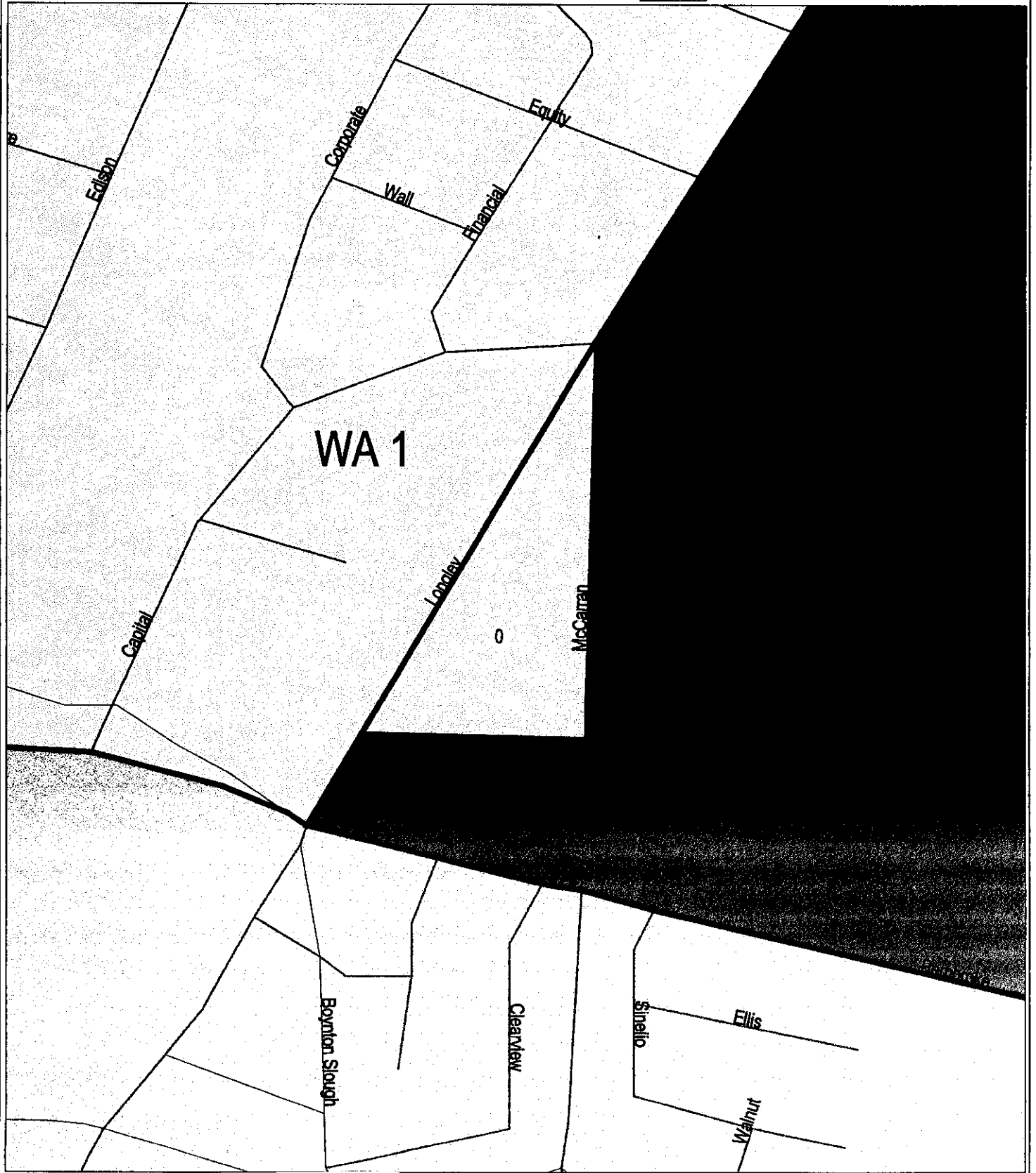

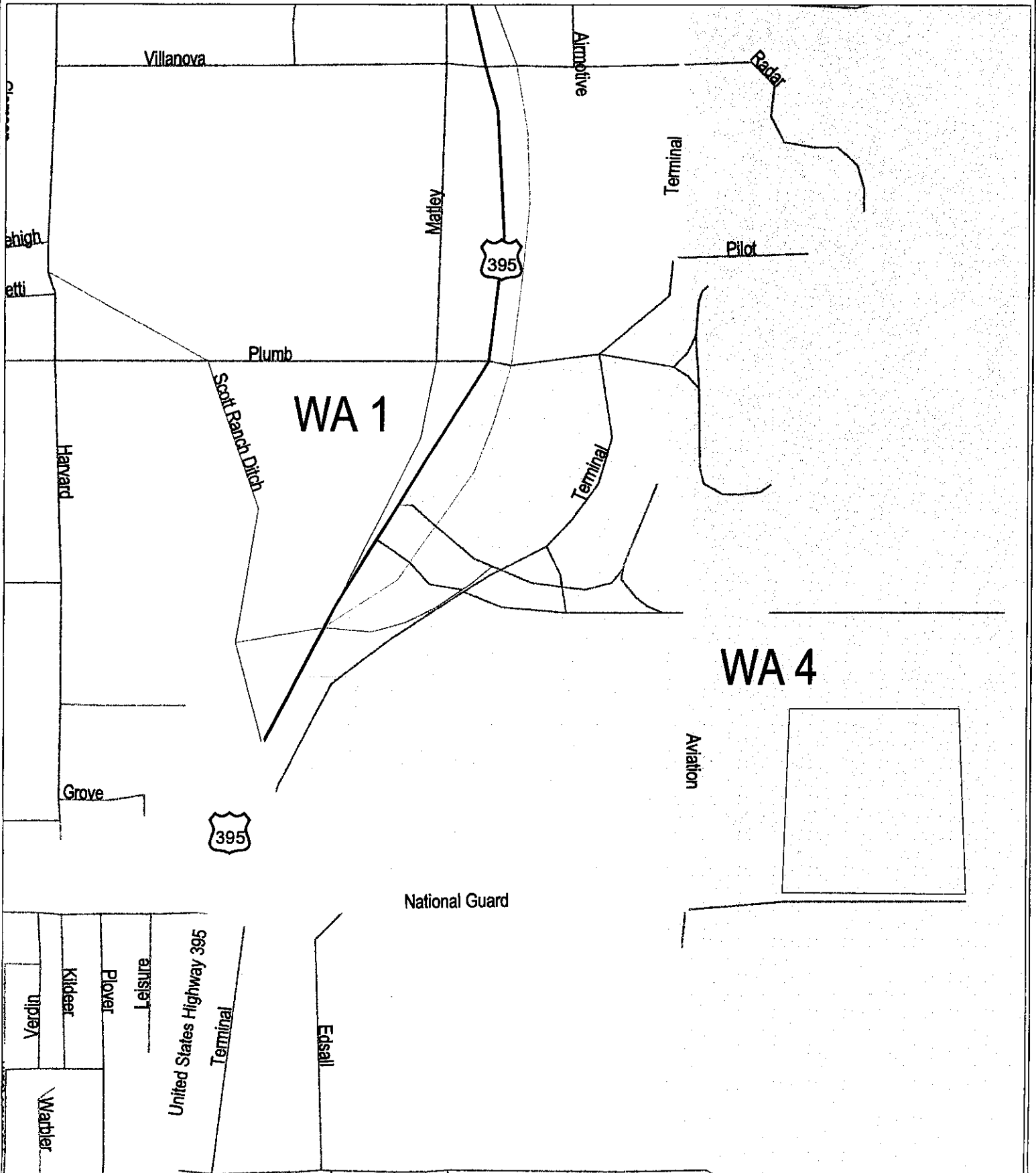


# Washoe County Senate Adjustments 2: From District Wa 1 to District Wa 4 Population Change: 0
