**Assembly Bill 114  
(As Introduced)**

**SUGGESTED AMENDMENT**

**Proposed by CLARK COUNTY NEVADA  
on behalf of the Constables of Clark County**

Amend section 1, page 1, by deleting "*and*".

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting line 1 and inserting:

*"2. He is a qualified elector; and*

*3. If the person is a candidate for constable in a county whose population is 250,000 or more, he is certified by the Nevada peace officers' standards and training commission as a Category I peace officer or a Category II peace officer at the time he files as a candidate for the office except that this requirement shall only apply on and after January 1, 2006, and shall not apply to any person who was elected or appointed to the office of constable in a county whose population is 250,000 or more prior to that date."*
