Suggested amendment to AB 84

March 5, 2003

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting lines 7 through 17 and inserting:

(b) A term of 4 years for members of the town advisory board, which must be staggered.

The ordinance must also provide that:

(1) If a person has served for a [a term] two consecutive terms as a member of a town advisory board, the person is not eligible for reappointment or reelection, as applicable, until 2 years after the expiration of his second consecutive term.

(2) Add, If a person was appointed to fill an unexpired term of more than 2 years on a town advisory board, the person shall be deemed to have served a full term of 4 years.

Amend the title of the bill by deleting the first through fourth lines and inserting "An Act relating to county government; changing the limitation on the number of terms of office for members of a town advisory board in certain counties; revising the"
