

## DISCLAIMER

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**Proposed Amendment to AB 249 – Sponsored by the State of Nevada Employees Association (by Dr. John Yacenda, SNEA Lobbyist)**

ADD to NRS 287.043(2), *subsection (k) that reads:*

*(k) Appoint a committee of eight (8) consisting of three state employees enrolled in the program, yet not sitting on the Board, a representative of the Employees' Association that represents the greatest number of state active and retired workers, a representative of non-state active employees, two professional health care advisors with experience in program evaluation, quality control and health insurance representing the interests of all program enrollees, and an ex-officio member from the staff of the Public Employees Benefit Program. The committee shall serve in an advisory capacity only, be engaged in the following duties, and make recommendations to the Board regarding:*

- (1) Program and benefit development;*
- (2) The preparation of and evaluation of requests for proposals necessary for the operation of the program;*
- (3) The design and implementation of the periodic evaluation of enrollee's perception of program benefits;*
- (4) The design and implementation of the periodic evaluation of the program's responsiveness to enrollees' needs;*
- (5) Periodic review of the administrative regulations necessary to operate this program.*

*The Board shall adopt regulations relating to the conduct of the advisory committee, the frequency of its meetings, its reporting schedule, and interface with staff of the Public Employees Benefit Program. Members shall serve at no cost to the state or the Public Employees Benefits Program.*
