ASSEMBLY BILL 114

Requires sheriffs and constables to be qualified electors and to be at least 21 years of age on date of taking office. (BDR 20-1020)

Assembly Bill 114 requires sheriffs and constables to be at least 21 years of age and to be a qualified elector.

Amendments:

An amendment was proposed by Clark County to add a requirement that constables in certain counties be certified by the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Commission in Chapter 289 of NRS. An amendment proposed by the Nevada Sheriffs & Chiefs Association would add a requirement for sheriff candidates in certain counties to have a four-year degree in a related field. Based on comments from members of the Committee and others, a compromise proposal has been brought forward.

A mock-up of the proposed amendments is attached.

Opposition:

There was no testimony in opposition to the bill although an email in opposition was received from a candidate who was

disqualified due to his age (20 years).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 248 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

No person is eligible to the office of sheriff unless:

1. He will have attained the age of 21 years on the date he would take office if so elected; and

2. He is a qualified elector.

Sec. 2. Chapter 258 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

No person is eligible to the office of constable unless:

1. He will have attained the age of 21 years on the date he would take office if so elected or appointed; and

2. He is a qualified elector.

Conceptual amendment: Add a provision requiring a candidate for sheriff in a county whose population is greater than 100,000 to be certified by the Nevada peace officers' standards and training (POST) commission as a Category I or Category II peace officer at the time of filing for office.

<u>Conceptual amendment</u>: Add a provision specifying that the new requirement for POST-certification applies **after January 1, 2006**, and does not apply to any person elected or appointed prior to that date.
