Assembly Bill 464 establishes a Commission to Review the Compensation of Legislators. The bill provides for a nine-member commission. The commission would make a determination on legislators' salaries and submit the determination to the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration for inclusion in the budget.

**Amendments:** Jim Richardson, representing himself in memory of Marvin Sedway, suggested an amendment on page 2, line 32 of the bill to add "(e) consider defining legislators as state employees for purposes of health insurance."
