The Board was created as it now is in 1987 when I introduced a bill to change the makeup of the Board from strictly a licensing board, to include customer complaints and there are many. The Board is to provide for mediation and hearings of complaints filed by users of Liquefied Petroleum Gas. See NRS 590.515.3 (3)(b)

There were to be 2 firemen, 2 persons representing the public and 1 L.P. Dealer. In 1991 the Dealers had 1 dealer added to the Board.

This should not be a "stand alone" board, It should be audited at the very least 1 time every 2 years.
