Explanation of amendment

The computer technology in the Recorder's office also significantly affects the offices of County Assessors, Clerks, and Treasurers as well as comprehensive planning functions conducted in other departments. The current statute calls for the Recorder to put forth a proposal prior to technology expenditure, assuring that technology purchased is compatible with these other important County offices.

The present process not only preserves the appropriate procedure for public purchasing but also promotes compatibility of technology. Section 3 of the first reprint could be interpreted to allow procurement outside normal public purchasing laws and could lead to purchase of incompatible technology and unnecessary expenditure of public funds.

For these reasons we propose Section 3 of the bill be deleted.
