## A.B. 503—Amendment

Offered by the Nevada Department of Agriculture

## Section 6, Subsection 4 (c) (4):

4-45 (4) One copy to the Board of Medical Examiners or Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

## Section 6, Subsection 5 (d):

- 5-30 not in good standing, as reported by the Board of Medical
- 5-31 Examiners or Board of Osteopathic Medicine;

**Rational:** AB 503 proposes to expand the definition of attending physician to include Osteopathic physicians. If this change is made, then other statutory revisions are required to clarify:

- 1. The Department of Agriculture needs to distribute submitted program applications to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine for review if the attending physician is an Osteopathic doctor; and,
- 2. The Department of Agriculture can deny a submitted program application if the attending physician is not in good standing, as reported by the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.
