I am writing to express my support of Assembly Bills 7 and 104 which reduce the concentration of alcohol that may be present in the blood or breath of a person operating a motor vehicle or vessel from 0.1 gram per 100 milliliters to 0.08 gram. As you know, I supported similar legislation when I served in the Assembly, and I continue to believe that this is valuable and necessary legislation.

Not only will this legislation bring Nevada into compliance with federal law and prevent the withholding of millions of dollars in highway funds, but it will also make Nevada's roads safer and Nevada's drivers more accountable for their behavior.
