Comments

This bill should receive strong support. Two suggestions for amendments to make it better:

- 1. Make it clear that it applies to anyone who currently has a prior felony DUI and is not limited to those who get their first felony DUI after the effective date of the statute; and
- 2. Recognize that if the per se level is reduced statutorily from .010 to .08, it needs to be made clear that references to prior felony convictions (and similar out-of-state convictions) include both levels of per se violation.
