36 (a) A person against whom the offense is committed.

37 (b) A person who is injured as a direct result of the commission
38 of the offense.

39 (c) If a person listed in paragraph (a) or (b) is under the age of
40 18 years, each parent or guardian who is not the offender.

41 (d) Each surviving spouse, parent and child of a person who is
42 killed as a direct result of the commission of the offense.

43 (e) A relative of a person listed in paragraphs (a) to (d),
44 inclusive, if the relative requests in writing to be provided with the
