Re: Amendment for AB-250

Instead of just mentioning the First Amendment in the amendment from Speaker Perkins I would suggest using the **sites from the Nevada Constitution** as an amendment.

Amend the definition of terrorism by adding at the end of the Perkins amendment #3 "and the Nevada Constitution Article 1 Declaration of Rights, Section 4 Liberty of Conscience, Section 9 Liberty of Speech and the Press, Section 10 Right to assembly and to petition, Sections 18 Unreasonable seizure and search..."

And possibly adding Section 3 Trial by Jury, Section 8 Due Process, Section 11 Right to Keep and Bear Arms."

All of these rights are in jeopardy under the federal PATRIOT ACT.
