> references "driver's license". The Department would recommend that the
> verbiage "driver's license" in the first and last sentence of the
> proposed
> language be replaced with the verbiage identification card.

> 1. Sec 33 subsection 3. The Department may refuse to accept a
> [driver's
> license] identification card issued by another state or the District
> of
> Columbia if the Department determines that the other state or the
> District
> of Columbia has less stringent standards than the State of Nevada to
> the
> issuance of a [driver's license] identification card.

> The Department would also like to recommend that Section 31 subsection
> 6
> and 7 also be added to Section 33. The addition of these subsections
> into
> Section 33 would ensure consistency by the Department in issuing both
> driver's licenses or identification cards.
