Testimony of Corie Craig Fannie Mae Assembly Committee on Judiciary May 8, 2003

Fannie Mae's mission is to increase affordable housing and homeownership. Fannie Mae's total investment in Nevada exceeds \$19 billion (compare to NV Housing Division).

Fannie Mae works with many <u>affordable</u> housing partners throughout Nevada. Some partners who have the ability to develop for sale affordable housing can only develop affordable <u>rental</u> properties, due to lack of available insurance. Local governments are begging for additional for sale affordable housing as home ownership helps to build a community.

Median sales prices for condo/townhouses (traditionally affordable for first time homebuyers) have increased disproportionately in the past year

Southern Nevada *

Market - 5.6% increase

Condos – 23% increase (excluding Turnberry and Park Towers)

Northern Nevada *

Market - 8% increase

Condos - 66.3% increase

We are concerned that any increase in costs of construction are passed along to the homebuyer, decreasing affordability
