We need strong defenders of the environment at all levels of government to protect our unique natural heritage, and our quality of life from air and water pollution, toxic waste, and other hazards.

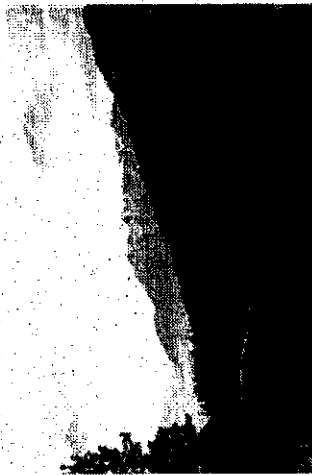

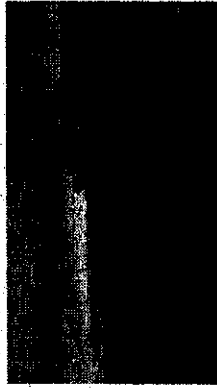

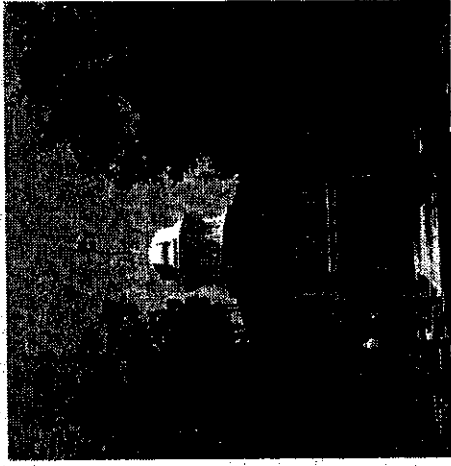
