

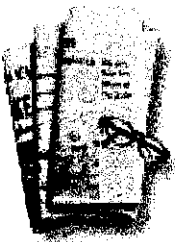

HOW CAN WE SAVE OUR BABIES?

While some were thinking about this question, Sandy Toles-Blake was busy designing the answer. After reading about the death of a 6-month old Las Vegas boy, who died June 2001, Toles-Blake was divinely given the answer to preventing such deaths in the future.

Sandy Toles-Blake, the Pastor of Love Center Unlimited, a non-denominational ministry founded on God's love, received the idea of Remember Baby from the Lord. She said: "In my inner spirit I know the Lord Himself said to me 'You do something about it' and it was so startling that I went to my computer and put something together."



From the first draft thru the prototype, Pastor Toles-Blake was divinely instructed as to how to design this alarm system that would notify drivers and vehicle occupants of the baby's presence in the vehicle.

This device is simply genius. It reminds anyone in the vehicle that the baby is still in the car seat. When the baby is placed in the car seat, initially, a voice module reminds the occupants, in English and Spanish, to "Remember Baby". It continues to sound until the ignition is turned on. Then, when the ignition is turned off in the vehicle, indicating the vehicle has reached some destination, the voice module begins the alert again: "Remember Baby", until the baby is removed from the car seat.

Remember Baby, fits any carseat.
