Dispatch records of the Las Vegas Fire Department indicate:

 590 children were rescued from inside locked vehicles, in 2000


 338 cases of children locked in vehicles had already been reported by July 1, 2001

 An average of 2 to 3 calls daily are responded to by rescue personnel.

Children have died in the Las Vegas valley because they were left in sweltering vehicles:

 3 children died last year, in Las Vegas, by July 7, 2001.

Outside temperatures can raise internal vehicle temperatures to lethal levels.

 93 degrees outside can raise vehicle temperature to:  
125 degrees in 20 minutes  
140 degrees in 40 minutes.
