Proposed Amendment to AB30

A person may receive a refund if (1) the portion of unused registration fee and governmental services tax is over \$100.00: (2) the person is a permanent Nevada resident: (3) and can provide documentation which, in the determination of the Department provides reasonable proof that extenuating circumstances exist.

The Department shall adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this subsection. The regulation shall provide that if the Department receives a request for a refund and the surrender of the license plates pursuant to this subsection, it may issue a refund to a person only if they meet the requirements set forth as "extenuating circumstances", including:

- 1. a person relinquishes his driver's license and has disposed of the vehicle;
- 2. a vehicle has been determined inoperable and does not transfer the registration to a different vehicle;
- 3. there is serious illness or death of the owner and survivors have disposed of the vehicle; or
 - 4. certain other catastrophic events as determined by the Department.
