Revenue is based on the number of Salvage Bills of Sale, from insurance companies, that are currently being processed. These figures are based on a 5-month survey of Department records and contact with 4 of the largest users of Salvage Bills of Sale. Additional research is in the process of being conducted with insurance agencies to verify the Department's calculations. 4FTE's are requested by Central Services and Records Division (3-Salvage Titles, 1-Teletype) to ensure a 48-hour (or less) turn-around time when processing the additional salvage titles. This BDR was amended to include the requirement for the 48-hour turn-around time. The result was the need for the four additional personnel to meet this requirement.
