TSA Enforcement Strategy and Activity

Mission:

Enforce NRS 706 and 712 and regulations of the TSA and DMV and public safety pertaining to NRS 482, 483.230, 483.350 and 483.530 to 483.620, inclusive, for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of NRS 706...pursuant to NRS 289.320.

Limiting Factors:

- Manpower 3 officers located in Sparks and 6 officers located in Las Vegas.
- Size of regulated industry approximately 297 companies with over 1500 Vehicles located throughout the state.

Enforcement Focus:

- Ensure the safety and protection of the Traveling Public;
- Identify and Eliminate uncertificated carriers;
- Ensure industry compliance with safety regulations;
- Ensure industry compliance with all other jurisdictional statutes and codes.
- Conduct investigations and respond to public's complaints.

Strategy:

- Direct maximum enforcement efforts during conventions and high volume tourist weekends.
- Complete application investigations in minimum time to allow businesses to begin operating as soon as possible.
- Perform Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) vehicle inspections on all vehicles before they go into operation.
- Ensure all certificated carrier's vehicles are CVSA inspected annually.

September, 2002

Las Vegas: Two Officers were assigned to work each Friday and Saturday, 3P-12M.

Sparks: One Officer was assigned to work each Friday and Saturday night, 3P-12M.

October, 2002

Las Vegas: Two Officers were assigned to work each Friday and Saturday night, 3P-12M (with the exception of October 25 — Nevada Day).

Sparks: One Officer was assigned to work Friday and Saturday night, October 4 and 5, 3P-12M.

November, 2002

Las Vegas: Two Officers were assigned to work each Friday and Saturday night, 3P-12M (with the exception of November 29 – Family Day).

Las Vegas: Four Officers were assigned to work nights Tuesday, through Thursday night, 11A-8P, November 5-7 to cover the Specialty Equipment Market Association (SEMA) and Automotive Aftermarket Products Expo (AAPEX) conventions. Necessary accumulated paid overtime: 38.5 hours does not include additional time of approximately 10 hours spent by Chief Investigator and Manager of Transportation.

- During the SEMA and AAPEX conventions, TSA Officers wrote three citations which resulted in total fines of \$4600:
- 1. One citation for violating NRS 706.386 (Operating Without Authority) and included the impoundment of a bus (Total fine of \$4000)
- One citation for violating NAC 706.360 (Use of Vehicle Beyond the Scope of Authority) (Total fine of \$500)
- 3. One citation for violating NAC 706.228 (Solicitation) (Total fine of \$100)

Las Vegas: Four Officers were assigned to work nights Tuesday through Thursday, 11A-8P, November 19-21 to cover the COMDEX FALL convention. **Necessary accumulated paid overtime:** 68 hours does not include additional time of approximately 8 hours spent by Chief Investigator and Manager of Transportation.
