Definition of Terms

A Docket Investigation is an investigation conducted by the **Docket Investigation** enforcement staff as a result of an application or petition submitted by the public or a certificated carrier (i.e. application requesting operating authority, petition to change name or domicile, petition to temporarily discontinue service or Voluntary Cancellation, petition to increase or decrease tariff, petition to expand or reduce authority, etc.). Enforcement Investigation -An investigation conducted by the enforcement staff as a result of a complaint from the public, observation while on patrol or self-initiated based on information collected. Written Warning - Administrative Warning issued to a carrier for a violation of a state statute or code in lieu of a citation. - Uniform or Administrative Citation issued to an individual Citation or company for violating a state statute or code. Arrest - Taking an individual into custody. - Taking a vehicle into custody pursuant to NRS 706.476. Vehicle Impound Carrier Contacts - Any contact with a carrier or his representative during duty hours. Agency Assists - Any assistance provided to another law enforcement agency. Vehicle Safety Inspection - A Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance inspection conducted on a certificated carrier's commercial vehicle or an inspection of a commercial vehicle carrying 8 passengers or less including the driver. **MRO** - Mechanical Repair Order is issued to a certificated carrier

Vehicle Out-of-Service

 Mechanical Repair Order is issued to a certificated carrier that identifies repairs that must be made to a vehicle following an inspection. Discrepancy is not serious enough to take a vehicle out of service.

 Violations identified in an inspection that precludes further operation of a commercial motor vehicle until a required repair is completed. The vehicle is not safe to operate.
