Proposed Amendment to Senate Bill 483

1. The Department may issue a driver's license to a person who is 16 or 17 years of age if:
  - a. he has held an instruction permit for not less than 6 months before he applies for the driver's license; and
  - b. he has at least 50 hours of supervised experience in driving a motor vehicle with a restricted license, instruction permit, or restricted instruction permit including, without limitation, at least 10 hours of experience in driving a motor vehicle during darkness.
2. A person who is 16 years of age shall not during the 90 days immediately succeeding the date on which the Department issues that license, transport as a passenger in a motor vehicle that he is driving any person under the age of 18 years unless that passenger is a member of his immediate family.
3. Delete current provisions restricting transporting passengers who are under 18 years of age for a person who is 17 years of age or older but less than 18 years of age on the date on which the Department issues a license to him.
