PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO AB 159

MARCH 5, 2003

Statement of Intent: Narrows definition of state employees performing certain dangerous duties involving railroad equipment

Amend Section 1(1)(c):

(c) Perform duties as railway safety specialists, certified by the Federal Railroad Administration, on, between, under or in the immediate vicinity of railroad equipment on a right-of-way or property of a railroad or at an industrial facility, including, without limitation, inspection of railroad cars containing hazardous materials. As used in this paragraph, "railroad equipment" includes, without limitation, locomotives, railroad cars and railroad tracks.
