Important Economic Data

- Direct & Indirect Job Loss – 23% (FY97 – FY02)
- Population Loss – 12% (FY97 – FY02)
- Student Population Loss - 23% (FY97 – FY02)
- Decrease in Assessed Valuation – 40% (FY97 – FY02)
- Decrease in Taxable Sales – 40% (FY97 – FY02: 49% from FY96)
- \$3.64 Tax Cap since 1995
 - Unable to issue bonds or capital projects levy
 - Tax base would have to triple to allow any local government to assess a capital levy or issue general obligation bond.
- City and town governments **unable to assess any** property taxes rate since – 2001
