Section 4. Beginning with the calendar year, 2004, the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy, will incorporate the following on the State Board's website:

The Office of Inspector General (OIG)in the Department of Human and Health Services has issued voluntary compliance programs for the health care industry.

The Compliance Guideline Program for the pharmaceutical industry includes:

- a. Implementing written policy and procedures
- b. Creating a compliance committee and designating a compliance officer
- c. Conducting effective training and education
- d. Developing effective lines of communication
- e. Conducting internal monitoring and auditing
- f. Enforcing standards through well publicized guidelines
- g. Responding promptly to detected problems and undertaking corrective action
