## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ASSEMBLY BILL 431

Section 14 Strike subsections 4 and 5 in their entirety.

Section 16, subsection 1, line 15, strike "for the following program year".

Section 19 subsection 1 (a) For a participant in the category of <u>private residence</u>, <u>small businesses</u>, schools or a participant in the category of other public buildings, the participant is entitled to renewable energy credits equal to twice the actual or estimated kilowatt-hour production of the solar energy system of the participant for a period of not less than ten years.

Section 19 (b) Strike all of the present section and insert the following: Participants in Section 19 (a) are entitled to credits equal to the greatest multiple for solar electric systems if any multiple greater than two is established during the course of the pilot program.

Subsection 19 subsection 3. Strike in its entirety.
