PROPOSED AMENDMENT by SENATOR CARE ADDING A NEW § 5 AND AMENDING § 6 (FORMER § 5) for discussion by the SENATE COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND LABOR

- Sec. 5. NRS 625.383 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 625.383 1. Each professional engineer and professional land surveyor shall obtain a stamp of the design authorized by the board, bearing his name and the number of his license and the legend "Professional Engineer" followed by the discipline for which he is qualified or the legend "Professional Land Surveyor," respectively.
- 2. To facilitate the obtaining of a stamp as required pursuant to subsection 1, the Board shall, upon request, provide its authorized design to any retailer or manufacturer of stamps. A professional engineer or professional land surveyor may obtain his stamp from any retailer or manufacturer of stamps.
 - 3. A professional land surveyor shall not use the legend "Professional Engineer."
- Sec. 6. 1. This section and section 5 of this act become effective upon passage and approval.
 - 2. Sections 1 and 3 of this act become effective on October 1. 2003.
 - 3. Section 1 of this act expires by limitation on June 30, 2010.
 - 12.1 4. Section 2 of this act becomes effective on July 1, 2010.
- 13.1 5. Section 3 of this act expires by limitation on June 30, 2010, if the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada publicly declares the establishment of the curriculum specified in section 17 of chapter 478, Statutes of Nevada 1999, on or before July 1, 2006.
