(e) To the extent authorized by federal law, prepare and submit a formal application to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the purpose of receiving and dispersing federal money for graduate medical education expenses;

(f) Identify ways to pool federal, state, and local funds to achieve health professional workforce objectives;

~~(f)~~-(g) Distribute a portion of any money appropriated to the Medical Education Council of Nevada from the State General Fund and any money received from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for graduate medical education expenses in a manner that:

(1) Prepares postgraduate medical and dental residents, as defined by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, to provide inpatient, outpatient and hospital services in various communities and in geographically diverse settings;

(2) Encourages the coordination of interdisciplinary clinical training by practitioners and other providers of health care to such postgraduate medical and dental residents; and

(3) Promotes funding for accredited clinical training programs provided by practitioners or other providers of health care to such postgraduate medical and dental residents;

~~(g)~~-(h) Apply for grants, gifts and donations from public and private sources, including the Federal Government, to carry out the objectives of the Medical Education Council of Nevada. All funding for this program shall be non-lapsing;

~~(h)~~-(i) Initiate a cooperative agreement with the Department of Human Resources to promote the intergovernmental transfer of money for the purposes of receiving and dispersing money to carry out the objectives of the Medical Education Council of Nevada; and

~~(i)~~-(j) Distribute additional financial resources to training programs for practitioners, other providers of health care or other personnel of health care facilities or programs in the State.

(k) adopt rules in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (title ---)

(l) Advise the Health Care Financing and Policy Division on the state Medicaid plan in support of health professions training including Graduate Medical Education.
