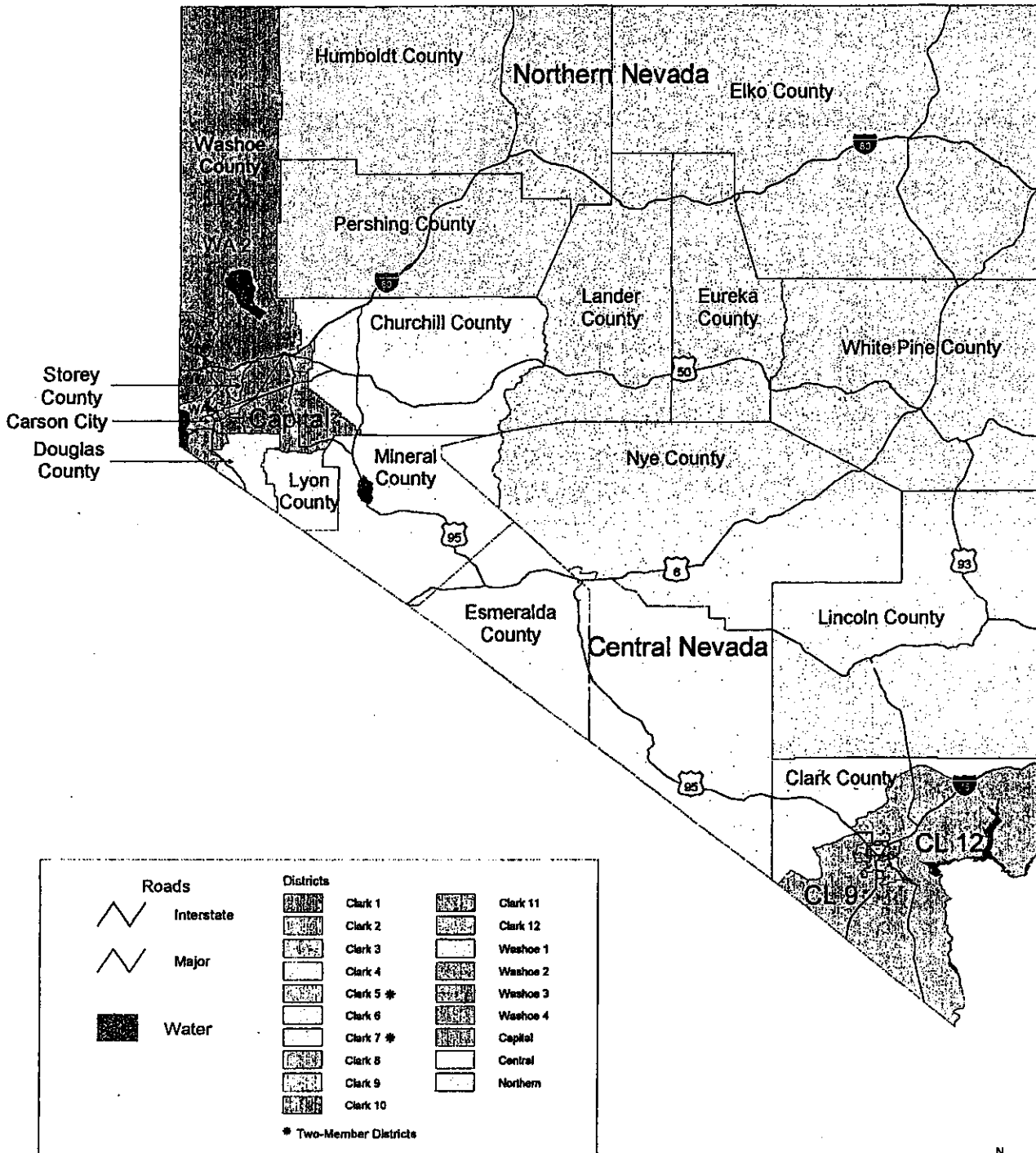
**Nevada Legislative District Size Analysis**  
**Senate and Assembly Districts over 3,000 Square Miles in Land Area**

|                 | District | Member                         | District Size<br>(sq. mi.) | Comparative Information  |
|-----------------|----------|--------------------------------|----------------------------|--|
| <b>SENATE</b>   | Capital  | Senator Mark E. Amodei         | 1,600.84                   | This district is 53 percent larger than the land area of Rhode Island.   |
|                 | Central  | Senator Mike McGinness         | 23,351.41                  | Eight states are smaller than this district. From Fallon to Mesquite is 432 miles, which is farther than Las Vegas to Salt Lake City by 17 miles.  |
|                 | Clark 12 | Senator Warren B. Hardy II     | 4,595.97                   | Clark Senate District 12 is more than twice as large as the State of Delaware.   |
|                 | Northern | Senator Dean A. Rhoads         | 73,113.72                  | There are 34 states smaller than this district. It is larger than all of England. The distance from Denio to Caliente is 502 miles. That is longer than the drive from Reno to Los Angeles. This district represents 67 percent of the total land area of the State of Nevada. |
|                 | Washoe 2 | Senator Maurice E. Washington  | 6,602.28                   | The district is larger than four states: Connecticut, Delaware, Hawaii, and Rhode Island.  |
| <b>ASSEMBLY</b> | 13       | Assemblyman Chad Christensen   | 1,702.09                   | Assembly District 13 is 63 percent larger than the entire State of Rhode Island.   |
|                 | 17       | Assemblyman Kelvin D. Atkinson | 1,594.18                   | This district is one and a half times bigger than Rhode Island.  |
|                 | 20       | Assemblyman Joe Hardy          | 4,246.19                   | District 20 is larger than each of the islands of Hawaii, including the "Big Island."  |
|                 | 32       | Assemblyman John W. Marvel     | 9,703.37                   | Eight states are smaller than District 32. It is bigger than Vermont by 452 square miles.  |

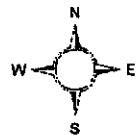

| ASSEMBLY | 33       | Assemblyman John C. Carpenter | 21,283.92                  | This district has an area greater than eight of the states.  |
|          | 35       | Assemblyman Pete Goicoechea   | 30,143.77                  | District 35 is larger than ten states, including South Carolina. Ely to Lovelock is 315 miles. That drive is longer than Reno to San Francisco by 93 miles.                                      |
|          | 36       | Assemblyman Rod Sherer        | 36,951.42                  | This district is larger than 12 of the states. The mileage from Fallon to Caliente is 366. It is nearly the same to go from Reno to Sacramento, back to Reno, and then back to Sacramento again. |
|          | 38       | Assemblyman Tom Grady         | 3,088.92                   | District 38 is bigger than the Hawaiian Islands of Oahu, Maui, and Kauai combined.   |
