- A.B. 122 (R1) Revises provisions governing calculation of basic support for school districts with declining enrollment. (BDR 34-963)
- A.B. 148 Requires Legislative Auditor to conduct audit of University and Community College System of Nevada and Board of Regents of University of Nevada. (BDR S-808)
- A.B. 162 (R1) Requires Legislative Auditor to conduct performance audits of certain school districts and provides for formation of Business Advisory Councils. (BDR S-995)
- A.B. 254 (R1) Makes supplemental appropriations to Department of Motor Vehicles for certain unanticipated shortfalls in money for Fiscal Year 2002-2003. (BDR S-1232)
