Subject: Senate Bill 144

The Division of State Parks, Department of Conservation & Natural Resources, submits the following revised language to this bill for the workshop scheduled 3/5/03.

SB 144: Section 2, Subsection 2, Proposed Revision

2. If a fee is charged pursuant to subsection 1, the fee must be charged in an amount that is based on the direct costs attributed to one grants administrator and associated travel, services, supplies and equipment.

~~(a) Based on the direct costs to the Division to administer these federal grants; and~~

~~(b) Not more than 10 percent of:~~

~~(1) The total amount of money provided for the outdoor recreational project; or~~

~~(2) Twice the amount of the federal grant provided for the outdoor recreational project, whichever is less.~~
