NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PAHRUMP LANDFILL VERTICAL EXPANSION

The Administrator, Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada, is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 44.570 through 44.7499, inclusive, and under the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 444.440 through 444.620 inclusive.

On March 19, 2003 the Administrator issued a Notice of Intent to approve a vertical expansion of a Class I disposal site for the following applicant: Nye County, Nevada.

The applicant is seeking authorization to vertically expand the Class I disposal site at: Pahrump Valley Landfill, NW1/4 NE1/4 and S1/2 NE1/4, Section 2, T.20S., R.53E., MDB&M.

On the basis of a review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes and implementing regulations,

the Administrator proposes to issue a permit modification to vertically expand the Class I Disposal Site. Issuing a permit modification for the vertical expansion is recommended to meet the short-term disposal capacity needs of Nye County.

Several requests by interested persons have been made for a public hearing regarding the proposed permit modification. In accordance with NAC 444.6415(3), the solid waste management authority has deemed it necessary to extend the period for public comment to May 28, 2003, the scheduled date of the public hearing. The applicant or any interested persons may comment on this proposed intent by the Administrator regarding the permit modification, by submitting their comments in writing to: Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 333 West Nye Lane, Carson City, Nevada 89706-0851. The Administrator has scheduled the public hearing pursuant to NAC 444.6415(2)(a) for 7:00 p.m. May 28, 2003 at the Bob Ruud Community Center in Pahrump, Nevada.

This public notice of such hearing will be issued and published in the Pahrump Valley Times at least 30 days before the date of the hearing.

In accordance with NAC 444.6419, after the close of the public review period the Administrator will issue a statement responding to written comments on the proposed approval of the permit modification. Copies of the statement will be sent to the applicant person(s) who submitted the written comments, and all other persons who specifically requested, in writing, a copy of the statement. A copy of this statement will be made available for inspection by

the general public at a location to be determined by the Administrator.

In accordance with NAC 444.6425, within 30 days after the public hearing, the Administrator will issue a permit to operate the disposal site, or, deny the application and send written notice to the applicant, which details the reasons why the application is being denied.
