ROLE OF HOMELAND SECURITY SPECIAL ADVISOR AS DEFINED BY GOVERNOR GUINN



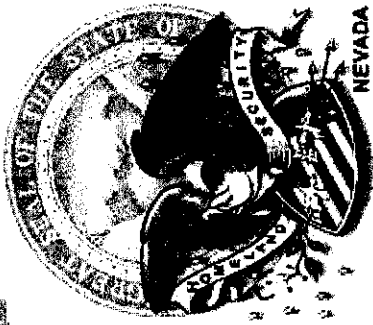
- **Advise Governor** on all Homeland Security issues, domestic and foreign, affecting the state;
- **Coordinate** and work closely with DEM in the delivery and implementation of Federal terrorism programs to include mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery initiatives;
- **Chair the state's Committee on Homeland Security;**
- Act as liaison and represent all state interests with applicable Federal agencies and officials;
- Act as liaison and represent all state homeland security interests to the **State Legislature;**
- Act as liaison between state, local and private officials in the development and implementation of statewide homeland security programs/initiatives;
- **Oversee** the coordination of all Federal terrorism-related programs provided to this state through FEMA, U.S. Office of Homeland Security, Department of Justice, U.S. Health and Human Services, and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (i.e., First Responder Initiative, Citizen Corp, Community Emergency Response Teams, Dam Protection, etc.);
- **Attend** all national, regional and state meetings/workshops relevant to homeland security topics, and
- **Oversee** the education of the media and public on homeland security issues.



During the next several years, significant new homeland security federal dollars may be available to Nevada. As the Homeland Security Advisor, I will serve as a single focal point for these federal funds. With approval of the Governor and the Legislature, I will oversee the process of obtaining these funds and coordinating investment decisions with all agencies to avoid conflicts, redundancies and misallocation of resources.

In the event of an incident, I will serve as the Governor's advisor and key-point of contact for operational decisions.

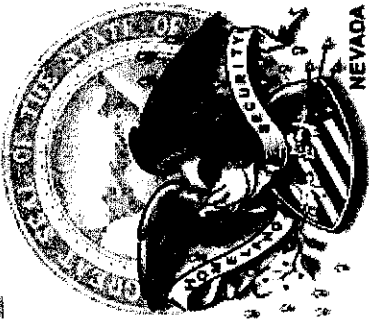
