Preserving Freedom & Nevada's Sovereignty With CCW Reciprocity

Provisions of BDR

- Protecting the sovereignty of Nevada Law by utilizing the standards set forth in NRS 202.3657 as the standard for Concealed Carry Weapon permits.
- 2. Directing the Attorney General to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states that meet the requirements contained in NRS 202.3657.
- 3. Defining reciprocity as the acceptance of Nevada CCW permits (without any additional application) in other states, and Nevada accepting CCW permits from the states (without further application) that, at a minimum, conform to NRS 202.3657
- 4. Reducing Law Enforcement resources required to process non-resident law abiding Concealed Carry Weapon permit holders, thus resulting in more resources available to protect citizens from those that carry concealed weapons without a permit
