8 *6. A birth parent may at any time request from the State Registrar of*
9 *Vital Statistics a contact preference form and medical history form that*
10 *shall accompany a birth certificate issued under section 1 of this statute.*
11 *The contact preference form shall provide the following information to be*
12 *completed at the option of the birth parent:*

13 *(1) I would like to be contacted.*

14 *(2) I would prefer to be contacted only through an intermediary.*

15 *(3) I prefer not to be contacted at this time. If I decide later that I would*
16 *like to be contacted, I will submit an updated contact preference form to*
17 *the State Registrar of Vital Statistics. I have completed an updated medical*
18 *history form and have filed it with the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.*

19 *The medical history form shall be in a form prescribed by the Department*
20 *of Vital Statistics and shall be supplied to the birth parent upon request of*
21 *a contact preference form from the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.*

22 *Only those persons who are authorized to process applications made under*
23 *section 1 of this section may process contact preference and medical*
24 *history forms.*

25 *The medical history form and contact preference form are confidential*
26 *communications from the birth parent to the person named on the sealed*
27 *birth certificate and shall be placed in a sealed envelope upon receipt from*
28 *the birth parent. The sealed envelope shall be matched with and placed in*
29 *the file containing the sealed birth certificate.*

30 *The sealed envelope containing the contact preference form and medical*
31 *history form shall be released to a person requesting his or her own*
32 *original birth certificate under section 1 of this section. The contact*
33 *preference form and medical history form are a private communication*
34 *from the birth parent to the person named on the sealed birth certificate*
35 *and no copies of the forms shall be retained by the State Registrar of Vital*
36 *Statistics.*

2 **available without fee.**

3 1. The state registrar shall charge and collect the following fees:

5 For searching the files for one name, if no copy is made..... \$8

9 For a certified copy of a record of birth..... 11

13 For replacing a record on file with the state registrar and providing a certified copy of the

18 For an index of records of marriage provided on microfiche to a person other than a
19 county recorder of a county of this state..... 200

26 2. The fee collected for furnishing a copy of a certificate of birth or
27 death must include the sum of \$3 for credit to the children's trust account.

28 3. Upon the request of any parent or guardian, the state registrar shall
29 supply, without the payment of a fee, a certificate limited to a statement as to
30 the date of birth of any child as disclosed by the record of such birth when
31 the certificate is necessary for admission to school or for securing
32 employment.

33 4. The United States Bureau of the Census may obtain, without expense
34 to the state, transcripts or certified copies of births and deaths without
35 payment of a fee.
