**FIRST REVISED AGENDA**

S.B. 378                      Revises provisions relating to cancellation or nonrenewal of policy of insurance issued to common-interest community. (BDR 10-1053)

S.B. 434                      Exempts from execution by creditors certain money held in trust forming part of qualified tuition program. (BDR 2-303)

S.B. 436                      Makes various changes to provisions pertaining to business. (BDR 7-982)
