<u>Add</u> a section to define: manufacture, packer, seller, distributor and recycler of antifreeze.

Section 1 (2) <u>Delete:</u> "A manufacture or packer of antifreeze this is required pursuant to this section to include a bittering agent" <u>Add</u>, "The department of Agriculture shall:"

Section 1 (3) <u>Delete</u> this subsection. <u>Add New Language</u>, "No antifreeze containing a bittering agent as defined in section 1 of this bill shall be deemed defective in design or manufacture, distribution, recycling or selling by virtue of the fact that it is, or contains denatonium benzoate or equivalent as required by this bill. If the safe harbor provided by this section does not apply, the existences of a design detect or manufacturing, distribution, recycling or selling defect shall be determined under otherwise applicable law."

Section 1, (4) Delete: "wholesale"

Section 4 (3) (c): Delete: "and the permit must be cancelled forthwith"
