Impact

- **As currently constructed, Senate Bill 308 will reduce and degrade the capability of the Clark County Fire Department to provide emergency service support to the residents of, and visitors to, Clark County**



Projected Impact

- Revenue loss to the Clark County Fire Service District of:
 - Year 1 \$3.5 Million
 - Year 2 5.8 Million
 - Year 3 8.2 Million

This equates to ...



Projected Impact

- **... approximately the amount needed to bring 4 Fire Stations on line to support the growth in the Las Vegas Valley**



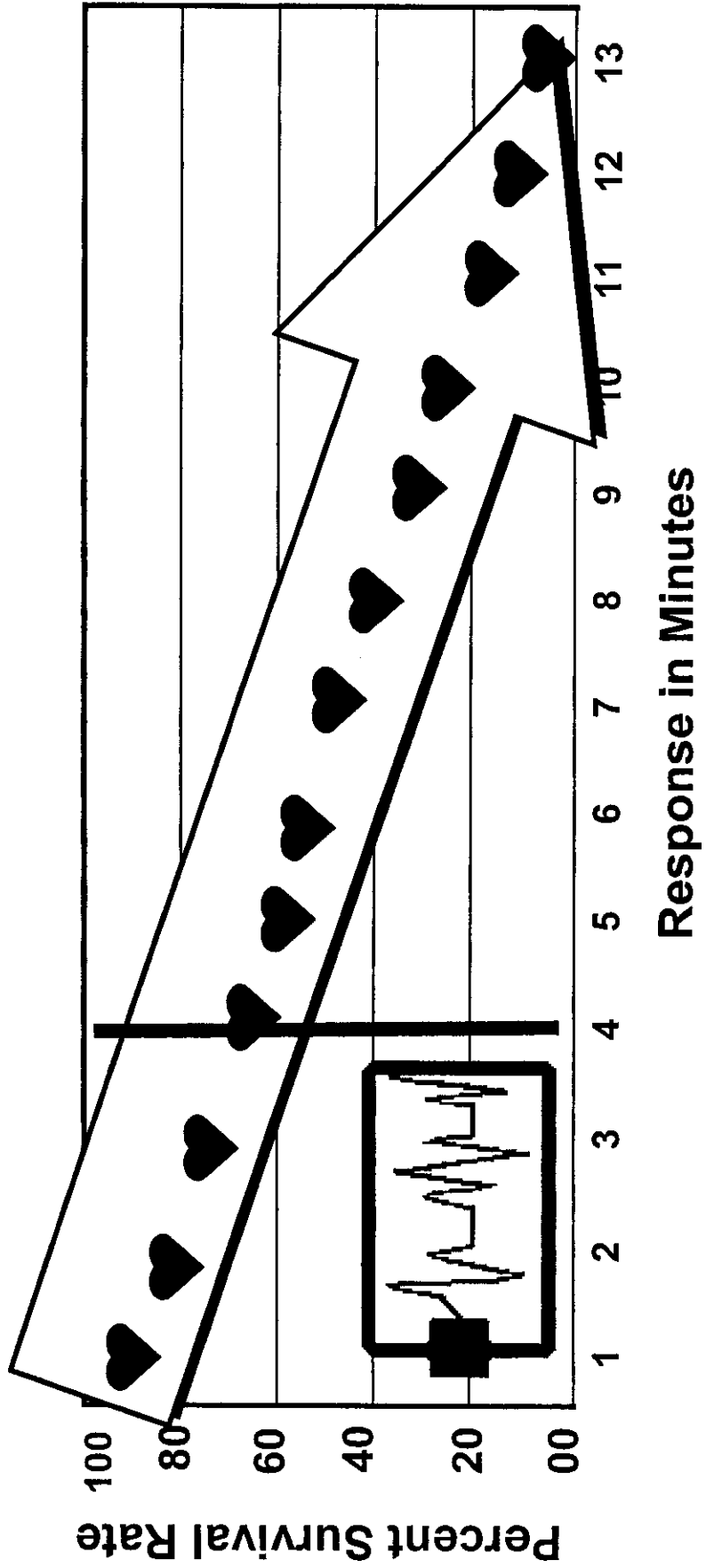
Result

- **Probable emergency service response time increase from goal of 4 minutes travel to as much as 15 – 20 minutes travel**
- **Probable outcomes:**
 - **Increased casualties**
 - **Increased fire loss**



Increased Casualties

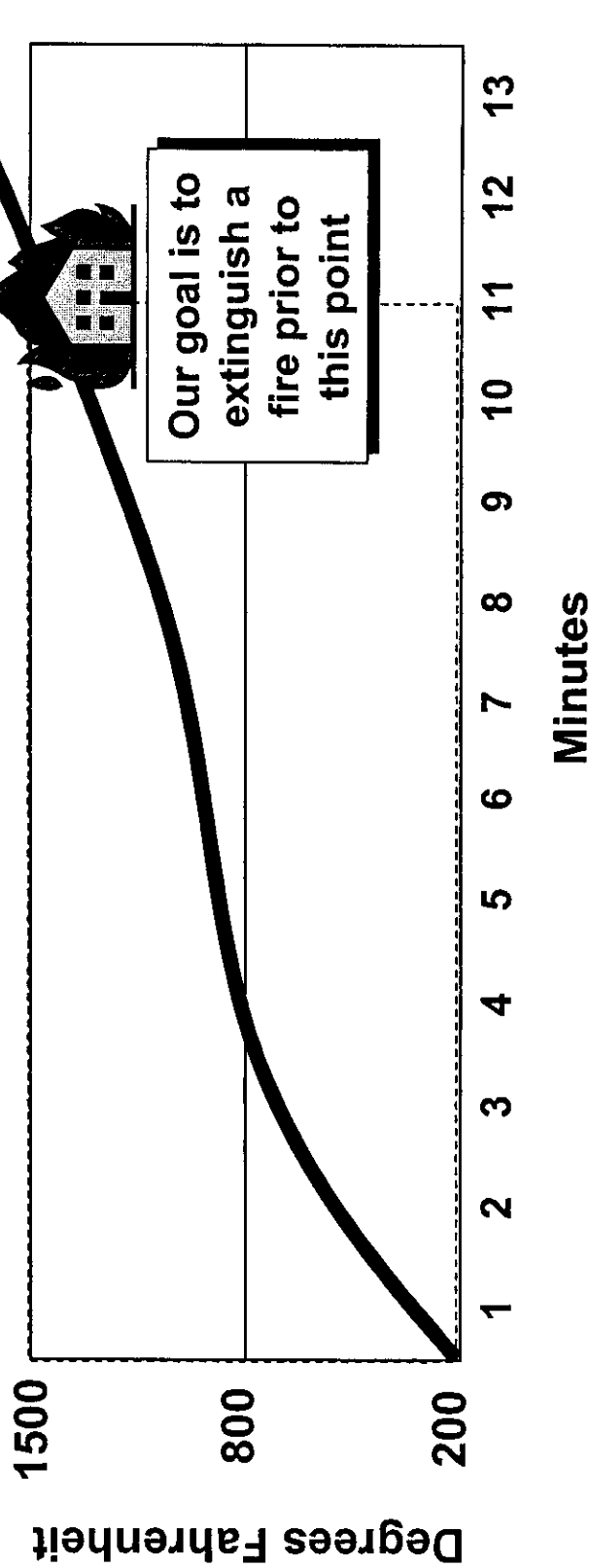
Cardiac Survival vs Response Time

Summary

- **Enactment of Senate Bill 308, as currently constructed, will materially impede the Clark County Fire Department's capability to provide emergency service support throughout the County and in particular, the high growth areas of the Las Vegas Valley**
