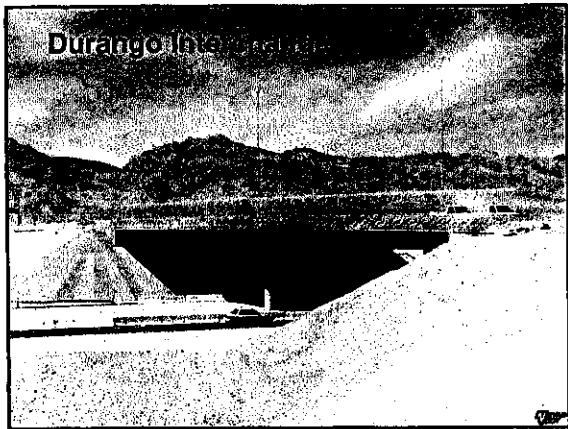



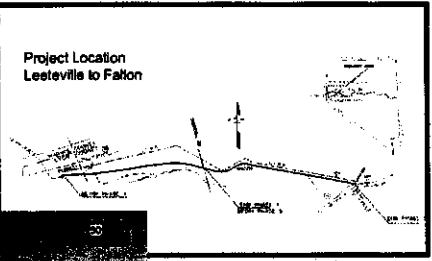

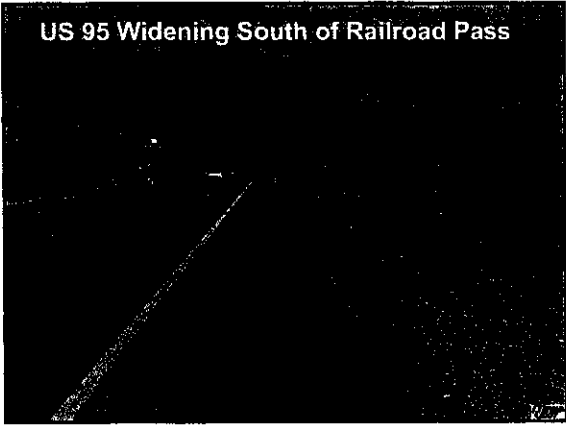

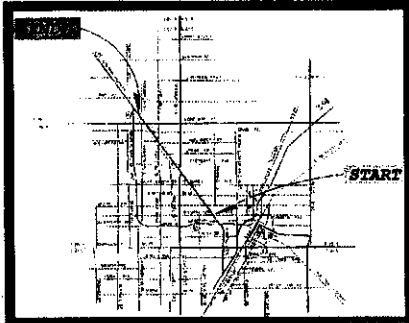

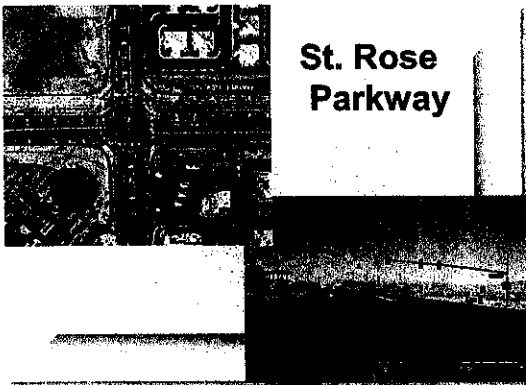

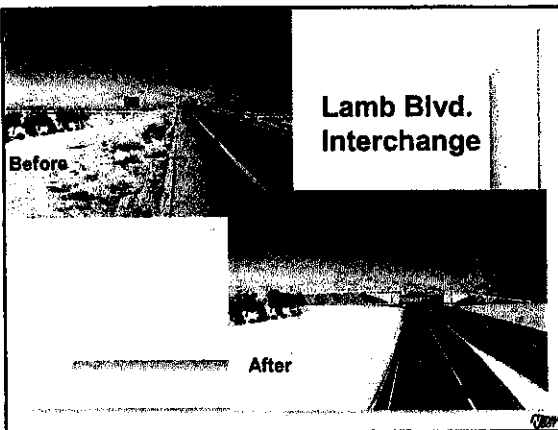

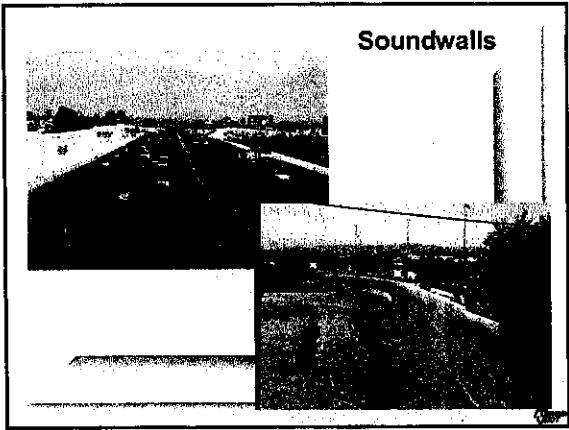

- US 95 Widening, Martin Luther King Boulevard to Craig Road, 13.4 miles of sound walls
- Reno Spaghetti Bowl renovation, 7 miles of sound walls
- Carson City Freeway, Phase 1, 4 miles of sound walls

Retrofit Projects:

- I-15 south of Sahara, west side – 2,625 ft
