SENATE BILL 202

Senate Bill 202 (Senators Raggio, Rawson, Schneider, Care, Hardy, et. al.): heard 3-25; work session 4-01)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for the issuance of special license plates for the support of the conservation of wetlands; imposing a fee for the issuance and renewal of such license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Representatives of Nevada Ducks Unlimited proposed the development of a special license plate. The applicable funds collected pursuant to this plate will be used to carryout certain projects for the conservation of wetlands and certain fundraising activities for the conservation of wetlands.

Lastly, a recommendation was presented which urged the Committee to consider combining the various natural resource and conservation related vehicle license plates. The recommendation proposed that the Department of Natural Resources receive fees collected pursuant to these plates, and that the fees be divided among the various organizations in accordance with the objectives of the various organizations and the overall strategic plans of the Department of Natural Resources.
