SENATE BILL NO. 355

March 31, 2003

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Sec.11.1(a) Propose the definition of a "new vehicle" not include limited miles.

Reason: In most cases, motor homes are driven from the manufacturer. The dealer receives most vehicles from the manufacturer with more than 1,500 miles. We believe that by limiting the mileage to 50 miles, motor homes may be automatically *excluded* from inclusion in the repurchase portion of the franchise law.

Proposal 1: ...As in this paragraph, a "new vehicle" is one which has not been damaged or materially altered.

Or:

Proposal 2: ... As used in this paragraph, a "new vehicle" is one which has not been damaged or materially altered and, if it is equipped with an odometer, registers no more than 2,500 miles on the odometer.
