## SB 479 Proposed Amendment from Nevada Judges Association

The purpose of the bill is to increase the payment/collection of outstanding court-ordered fines, fees, administrative assessments and restitution by establishing an electronic exchange of information between the courts and the Department of Motor Vehicles. Victims of Crime, the courts, the criminal repository, POST and AOC would all benefit from SB 479.

The purpose of this amendment is to allow time for both the Department of Motor Vehicles and the courts to complete the electronic networks needed to facilitate the data exchange. The amendment also gives the Department of Motor Vehicles authority to establish the type and format of data needed and define the procedures for the exchange.

Amend Section 2, subsection 3 (c) to read: If the defendant is the registered owner of a motor vehicle, file an electronic notice of nonpayment of the fine, fee, assessment or restitution with the Department of Motor Vehicles using the format and procedures as specified by the Department and when the Department can accept the notice electronically.

Strike Section 2, subsection 3 (c) and the three lines below it prior to Section 2, subsection 3 (d) because it is all covered above.
