Proposed Amendment to Senate Bill 187

Submitted by Senator Dennis Nolan 4/10/03

Remove the requirements related to the adoption of ordinances by county or city regarding the enforcement of NRS 484.408, and require each county and city to institute certain procedures and an informational campaign related to the erection and maintenance of signs designating parking spaces for use by handicapped persons. The following elements must be included:

- > Creation of a flier, which outline the requirements of the law (Americans with Disabilities, NRS 484.408, and local ordinances) related to handicapped parking and related signage, and the penalty that may be imposed for incompliance.
- > Increased training for building inspectors, and a requirement that they only sign off on signage once the requirements of the law have been met. Such inspectors are to be responsible for ensuring that the previously approved plans are followed when construction takes place.
- > Inclusion of the flier in all business license renewal mailings.
- > Provide copies of the flier to the local law enforcement agency for their information and distribution.
- > Provide a letter informing the local Chamber of Commerce (and other such organizations) of the handicapped parking requirements, and a request that they share the information with their members.
