Now is the time to "stand up" for those who can not. There have been several attempts to produce voluntary compliance with erection of appropriate signage since SB 338 of the 1997 Legislative session.

You have before you a legal opinion from LCB Legal that it is already a misdemeanor to not erect signage, this bill permits the counties and municipalities to establish a fine structure for violating this provision of NRS, and give the property owners appropriate notice to erect signage that would cost approximately \$10 rather than face an exponential amount in addition to a misdemeanor conviction.

You will hear from someone today that allegedly represents Clark County in this matter, although they have never been given the aforementioned information, as evidenced by the non-mention of the misdemeanor legal opinion.

Please pass SB187 today!
