Based upon information provided by the state's wholesale fuel suppliers and NDEP, the state purchased 141,000 gallons of #2 diesel fuel in Washoe County and 233,000 gallons in Clark County during a recent 12 month period that included most of 2002. The cost of B5 is anticipated to be\$.05 per gallon higher than #2 diesel according to the states's fuel wholesaler in northern Nevada \$.10 per gallon higher in Clark County according to NDEP. It is reasonable to assume that passage of this bill would increase demand for B5 and should decrease the per gallon price difference between it and #2 diesel.
