- City of Henderson – \$11,000 per year for increased sludge disposal costs.
- City of Las Vegas – \$30,000 per year.
- City of North Las Vegas – No fiscal impact.
- City of Reno – \$3,915 in FY 2004; \$248 in FY 2005; \$257 in future biennia.
- City of Ely – Indeterminate impact will result.
- City of Sparks – Did not provide a response.
- Nevada League of Cities reports that commercial waste provisions would require “new onboard scale installation” costs that may be the responsibilities of smaller cities.

Nevada's counties reported the following fiscal impacts:

- Carson City – \$10,000 per year.
- Churchill County – No fiscal impact.
